



Volunteer Role: Patron Picks Book Reviewer

Overview

This unique volunteering opportunity allows community members to engage with the Library remotely and at their own convenience while serving to generate interest among fellow patrons by sharing your opinions of La Crosse Public Library materials.

General Review Guidelines

Reviewers are invited to select any title for review. Be sure to include the title, author and any other relevant information (e.g. book one in XYZ series). While there is no minimum / maximum text limit, please consider keeping the review as concise as possible to generate interest among fellow patrons.

What is this Book About?

Try to relay the essence of the book in a few sentences, capturing the main highlights of the genre and broad strokes of main characters, plot, etc., (keep in mind, this is not a book report so no need to try to summarize the whole book - or give away the ending!)

What did you think?

What drew you to the book, and what did you find enjoyable or not? Think about what a potential reader would want to know in order to peak their interest. Again, keep in mind that the review should serve as the book trailer rather than the movie.
